I have had the pleasure of directing hundreds of lighting and camera crews both domestic and international including:

MISSION IMPOSSIBLE: DEAD RECKONING, PART 1 (2023 action/thriller)

Lighting actor Tom Cruise in five locations around the city of Rome, Italy while coordinating with JPI and local Coming Soon crew for press junkets and specialty outlets. Locations included a roof top, hotel suites, various restaurants, and a glass theater.

Virtual Junket Kits (2020 – 2024 A-list celebrity focused)

During Covid, I was part of a new medium that became a game changer. I learned a new technology to set and record virtual junket kits for major film productions via Zoom & WebEx. The kits were delivered to celebrity homes or remote locations allowing them to conduct interviews remotely while maintaining a safe and cost-effective way to promote projects. The kits remain prevalent today.

GODZILLA, KING OF THE MONSTERS (2019 action/sci-fi)

DETECTIVE PIKACHU (2019 family/action)

Traveled to Tokyo, Japan in coordination with Toho studios to light various interior and exterior locations throughout Japan in conjunction with both feature films for long lead press event and various setups with Ryan Reynolds.

SKYSCRAPER (2018 action/adventure)

Adventurous lighting and filming experience in Hong Kong, China with star Dwayne Johnson and various cast members. Highlights included shooting out of the windows of the International Commerce Center, Hong Kong's tallest building and various locations shooting on a traditional Chinese junk sailing vessel at night.

JURASSIC WORLD: FALLEN KINGDOM (2018 action/sci-fi)

Traveled with crew to the iconic destination of Kualoa Ranch, Hawaii. Extensive lighting of exterior locations along the cliffs of the ranch. Along with the staging crew, we built 20x20 platforms outrigged from a dirt road to enhance the view across the iconic Kualoa Valley.

A busy year for actor Tom Cruise as he juggled two feature films. Non-stop lighting experience with travel to London, England, Paris, France, Yanping, China and Mexico City, Mexico. We traveled to light various locations including interior, exterior and stunt lighting.

DUNKIRK (2017 war/action)

Lighting of 4-shooting areas with 3 WWII fighter planes in the Barker Hangar in Santa Monica, California staged as the Dunkirk pier. Employed a rear screen projection as the sky and lapping waves as the background. Moving lights, cobblestone floor patterns and water movement on the floor, really made you feel like you were in Dunkirk.

BATMAN V. SUPERMAN: DAWN OF JUSTICE (2016 action/sci-fi)

High energy lighting projects working with Warner Bros public relations department including set layout, press walks, costume design, the infamous Batmobile and the LexCorp headquarters. Moving lights and scene changes really made it a spectacle.

TRANSFORMERS: DARK OF THE MOON (2011 action/sci-fi)

Traveled to Moscow, Russia for the film and a special concert featuring the band, Linkin Park. Lighting for 4-room interior, two roof top sets and stand-up interview setups in Red Square. Also covered the Linkin Park concert for the feature film soundtrack under the supervision of armed military guards.
