

*The Gloria Record Encounter:* Three scientists invent a time machine and try to use it to loot a treasure ship that sank 356 years ago.

*The Haunted Mansion:* A spec script based on the Disney Theme Park ride. In 1910, three kids in Louisiana try to break the 47-year-old curse of Captain Bloodlust, in order to save their town and keep the Haunted Mansion as a home for the ghosts. (I am including this as an example of adaptation.)

*The Summit:* A man who loses his feet in a car accident proves his worth by scaling a Montana peak with a legless vet.

*Summer Santa:* Will the North Pole be able to survive a hostile takeover when Santa goes on vacation?

*Union:* In an alternate timeline where the Confederates won the war, the Union States and the Confederate States of America exist as two separate countries. But when an act of terrorism threatens both nations, the presidents of these divided nations, united by a dark secret, must work together.
